

BACKGROUND

After finishing his training at UBC, Dr. Truong completed a Fellowship at the Alberta Urology Institute in Edmonton focusing on Laparoscopic Pelvic and Retroperitoneal Surgery

His areas of interest include Laparoscopic Nerve Sparing Radical Prostatectomy for Localized Prostate Cancer, Laparoscopic Radical and Partial Nephrectomy for Localized Renal Cell Carcinoma, and Laparoscopic Adrenalectomy for functional adenomas and pheochromocytomas

He and Dr. Omar Nazif work closely together and are developing a strong minimally invasive Urology program in the Fraser Health Authority, which is Canada's largest Health Authority.
