BACKGROUND

Dr. Omar Nazif is a graduate of the UBC Urology Residency Program. He practices urology in Surrey, BC. He is fellowship trained in laparoscopy and endourology and specializes in minimally invasive surgery of the kidney, adrenal, and prostate. He also specializes in the endourologic management of stone disease.

Areas of interest include laparoscopic radical prostatectomy with nerve sparing technique for localized prostate cancer, laparoscopic radical and partial nephrectomy for localized renal masses, laparoscopic adrenalectomy for the treatment of functional and non functional adrenal masses. Other areas of specialization include endourologic management of stone disease with ureteroscopy, nephroscopy, percutaneous nephrolithotomy, and laser lithotripsy. He is fellowship trained in extra corporeal shock wave lithotripsy for treatment of stone disease. He also specializes in KTP (Green Light) laser photovaporization for the treatment of benign prostatic hyperplasia.

Dr. Nazif is actively involved in the BC Urological Society and the Canadian Urological Association. He is a Clinical Assistant Professor in the Department of Urologic Sciences UBC, where he is involved in undergraduate and postgraduate medical education. He was the valedictorian of his medical school class. He has published papers and presented at various conferences.
